



Early Head Start program expanded in Mesa

Child Crisis Arizona is expanding its Early Head Start program to Mesa at 817 N. Country Club Drive.

The program will now serve more than 100 children and create 30 jobs, expanding the agency's workforce to 300.

The program will include six classrooms that will provide services to 48 children. Home-based service will now be available for 64 children and pregnant women. Construction and renovations are expected to begin in September.
